Hiring Smart: Insights from Dr. Peter Simmons on Employee Selection

At a recent Chamber event, Board Member Dr. Peter Simmons shared valuable insights on why hiring decisions are among the most important and costly choices a business makes. His presentation offered three clear takeaways for business owners and managers.

1. The Cost of a Wrong Hire

Hiring the wrong person can be expensive.

Research suggests that the true cost of a poor hire can range from 30 percent of the employee's salary to as much as 200 percent, when factoring in turnover, re-advertising, re-evaluating candidates, and retraining. Dr. Simmons reminded members that using proven, evidence-based hiring methods pays off in the long run.

2. Understand the Job Before Hiring

Reducing mistakes starts with Job Analysis—understanding what the role requires and how it fits within the organization. Beyond specific tasks, job analysis helps identify the skills, personal traits, and characteristics that contribute to success in the position. The clearer the job profile, the better the match between employer and employee.

3. Use Research to Strengthen Teams

Organizational psychology offers practical tools to help employers make better hiring choices. Applying these research-based principles increases the likelihood of selecting the right person, improving team cohesion, and enhancing overall organizational effectiveness.

Hiring the right person is not a matter of luck; it is the result of preparation and strategy. Businesses that invest time in understanding their positions and applying proven selection techniques build stronger, more successful teams.


